

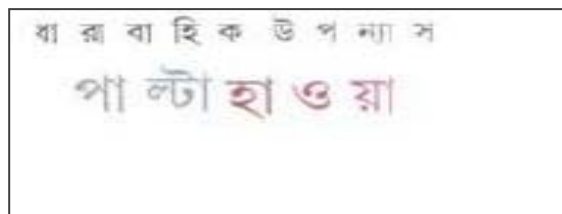

Summary: styling of horizontal spacing in Indian languages

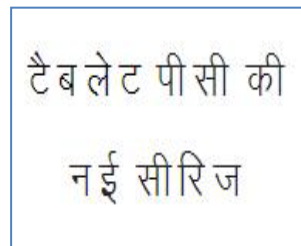
Description:

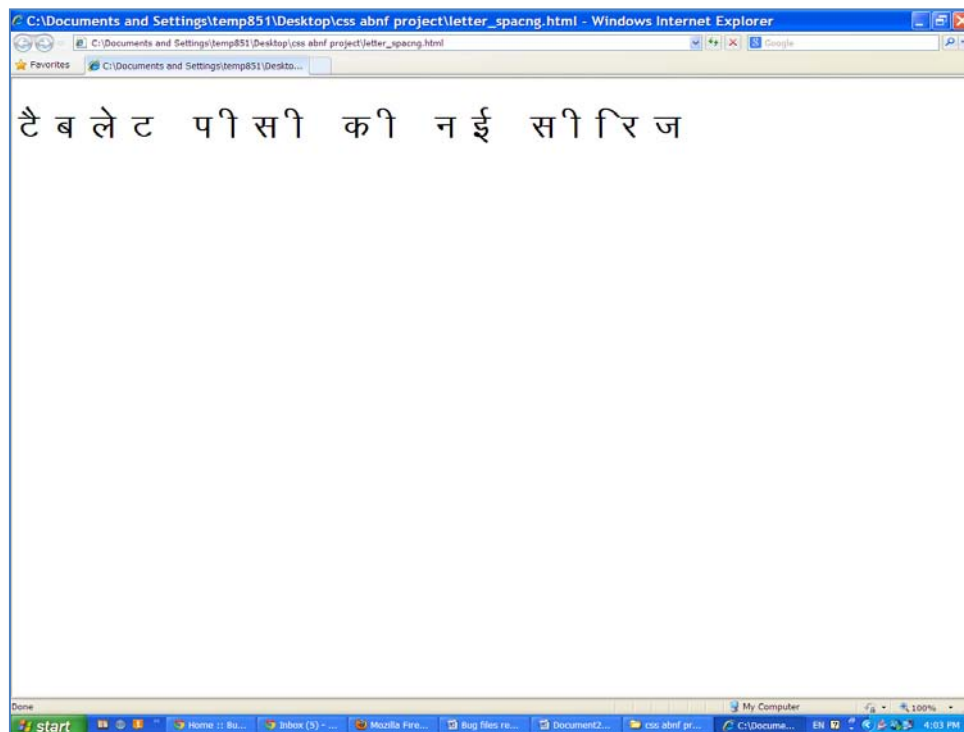

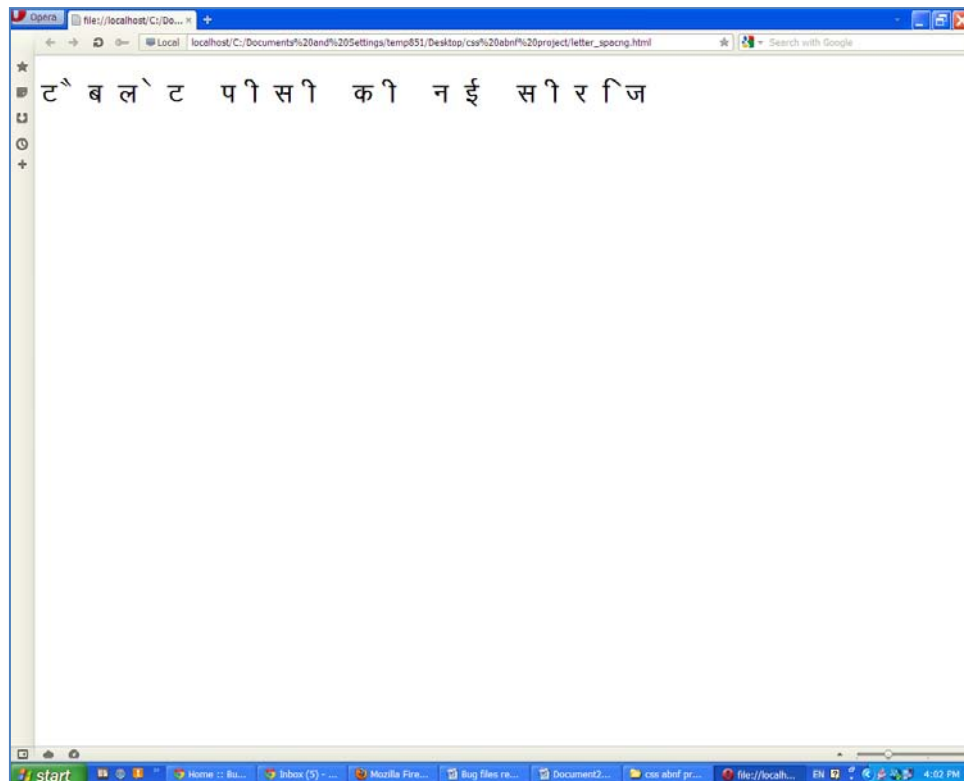
